FACTORIES, MACHINE SHOPS, METAL-WORKING MILLS, FOUNDRIES

CANNERIES, MEAT PACKING HOUSES, SMOKEHOUSES, STORAGE

DAIRIES, WINERIES, BOTTLING PLANTS

Fabulene cleans metal, plastics, stainless steel and machine tools, of fats and oils, U.S.D.A. approved for equipment, tools, labels removal, floors and fixtures, refrigerators, tanks, vats and personnel changing rooms. Fabulene emits no odor or hazardous fumes.

PAPER PROCESSING INDUSTRY

U.S.D.A. approved Fabulene emulsifies and removes animal and vegetable grease including baked on carbon and grease on fryers, baking pans, fans, hoods, ducts, floors and stainless steel equipment. Fabulene emulsifies and removes dough and shortening rapidly. Use Fabulene on floors, walls, counters, waste storage areas, containers, and cooking vats.

TRANSPORTATION, TRUCKING, AUTOMOTIVE, AIRLINES AND RAILROADS

Fabulene also cleans carpets. Use Fabulene to strip wax from asphalt, vinyl, tile, rubber, linoleum, congo-leum, marble, terrazzo and other composition floors.
